From the Pastor's Desk...

Greetings children of God.

Right in the middle of February is "Valentine's Day," the day of love. There it sits on the 14th, reminding us of the love St. Valentine had for his girlfriend, and the love he had for Jesus (as he was then killed for his faith on this very day). This day becomes an important image for the whole month, and ultimately for our faith as well. For we believe in and proclaim that God is love, and that all love comes from God.

And the greatest example of love that came from God, was the gift of Jesus, his only begotten Son, whom God sent to us, to not only become one of us, but to become one with us. In Jesus, God became fully human, so he could experience the same trials and difficulties of life we experience. So, he could be faced with the same temptations and sins we're faced with. So, Jesus could identify with us and more importantly, so he could take on the sins of the whole world, and by his crucifixion, death, and resurrection, overcome them, put an end to the threat of death, and through our baptism into Jesus' resurrection, wash away our sins, make us one with him, and grant us the gift of eternal life.

John 15:13 says, "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." That's how much God loves us. That he came to us in human form, that he lowered himself to the form of a slave, that he, perfect and sinless, took on our sin, bore our shame, laid down his life for us as he willingly went to the cross, and bore the torturous death meant for us. Now, it's our turn to show at least some of that love to the world and do our best to help make it a better place.

And a great way for us to remember how much we're loved by God, so we can share that love with the world, is by remembering our baptism. Each morning during the month of February, as you're getting ready for work or just for the day, turn the faucet on, place you hand under the running water, look in the mirror, make the sign of the cross on your

forehead as was done at your baptism, and say the words, **I am God's beloved child!** If you're diligent and intentional about doing this, I believe your outlook on life will be better, I believe you'll be better able to share God's love with others, and I believe you will help make the world a better place by doing so.
